Los Angeles, CA (March 2, 2021) — ONE Archives Foundation announces the launch of ***Metanoia Online***, an interactive web exhibit that provokes and explores the question: What happens when we center HIV history around Black women’s experience and contributions to AIDS Activism?

Metanoia Online — launched February 24, 2021 — is created by ONE Archives Foundation with curatorial guidance from Katherine “Kat” Cheairs, creative direction from our Director of Content Strategy Umi Hsu, and design and production support by our Exhibitions Intern Fati Zulaikha.

Metanoia Online is the third instantiation of the exhibition first launched at the LGBT Center in New York City (Winter 2019) and at the ONE Gallery, West Hollywood (January 2020). The original exhibition ***Metanoia: Transformations through AIDS Archives and Activism*** is curated by Katherine Cheairs, Alexandra Juhasz, Theodore (ted) Kerr, and Jawanza Williams
