West Hollywood, CA — The ONE Archives Foundation, Inc. is pleased to announce **The Butler Art of Stephen Warble Sanctusper Performance Art in the 1970s, photographs by Greg Day**. Curated by David J. Getag, Professor at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, the exhibition brings to light the work of performance artist Stephen Warble (1946–1988) through the photographs taken by Greg Day (b. 1944) of his costumes, performances, and collaboration.

In costumes made from street trash, food waste, and stolen objects, Stephen Warble took to the streets of 1970s New York City to perform his “Butler Art.” With disruption as his aim, he led uninvited costumed teams through the galleries of home, occupied 1980s Avenue galleries, and back into bars and boutiques in his greater confounding endeavors.

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
