Transgender: An umbrella term that refers to a broad range of identities and experiences of people whose gender identity and/or expression differs from their assigned gender or sex at birth.

Gender Identity: A person's internal sense of themselves or their gender.

Gender Non-Conforming: Someone who does not conform to the political, social, or cultural expectations of gender or gender expression in their society (masculinity, femininity, androgyny, etc.)

Gender Expression: Gender expression is how someone outwardly expresses their gender to the world around them.

Gender Binary: A system that upholds the view that gender exists in only two, opposite categories, termed "male" and "female" or "man" and "woman." The gender binary asserts no other possibilities for gender identity or expression exist.
